1. Islamabad Club invites sealed bids from well-reputed, registered firms for the "**Operation and Maintenance of Electronic Scoreboard including Hardware and Software at Islamabad Club Cricket Ground**".
2. The procurement will be conducted under **Single Stage - Two Envelope Bidding Procedure** as per Rule 36(b) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2004.

SECTION 2: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS (ITB)

A. GENERAL

ITB 1. Scope of Bid

1.1 The Employer (Islamabad Club) invites bids for the Operation and Maintenance of the Electronic Scoreboard as detailed in these documents.

1.2 The successful bidder shall be expected to commence services from the date specified in the Contract.

ITB 2. Eligible Bidders

2.1 This invitation is open to all bidders who:

- Are registered with SECP/Registrar of Firms
- Possess valid NTN and are on Active Taxpayers List of FBR
- Have valid Sales Tax registration
- Have relevant experience in scoreboard operation, software maintenance, and electronic display maintenance

ITB 3. One Bid per Bidder

3.1 Each bidder shall submit only one bid. A bidder submitting more than one bid will be disqualified.

ITB 4. Cost of Bidding

4.1 The bidder shall bear all costs associated with bid preparation and submission. The Employer shall not be liable for any such costs.

ITB 5. Site Visit

5.1 Bidders may visit the Club to inspect the existing scoreboard and assess the requirements. Prior appointment shall be required.

ITB 7. Clarification of Bidding Documents

7.1 Any request for clarification must be submitted in writing at least five (5) days prior to the bid submission deadline.

C. PREPARATION OF BIDS

ITB 8. Language of Bid

8.1 The bid and all related correspondence shall be in English.

ITB 9. Documents Comprising the Bid

9.1 The bid shall comprise two separate envelopes submitted simultaneously:

Financial Bid (Envelope-B) shall contain:

9.2 Disclosure of financial information in the Technical Bid shall lead to disqualification.

ITB 10. Bid Prices

10.1 The contract shall be for a fixed monthly fee as quoted in the Financial Bid.

10.2 All duties, taxes, and levies shall be included in the quoted price.

ITB 11. Bid Currency

11.1 All prices shall be quoted in Pakistan Rupees (PKR).

ITB 12. Bid Validity

12.1 Bids shall remain valid for **One Hundred Twenty (120) days** from the bid submission deadline.

ITB 13. Bid Security

13.1 Bid Security amount: **Rs. 50,000/-** .

13.2 Form: Pay Order/Demand Draft/Bank Guarantee from a Scheduled Bank in Pakistan in favor of "Islamabad Club".

13.3 Validity: Thirty (30) days beyond the bid validity period.

13.4 Any bid without an acceptable Bid Security shall be rejected as non-responsive.

13.5 Bid Security may be forfeited if the bidder withdraws the bid during validity or fails to sign the contract/furnish performance security.

D. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

ITB 14. Sealing and Marking

14.1 Bidders shall submit their bids through EPADS.

14.2 The original Bid Security (CDR/PO/BG) must be delivered in a sealed envelope superscribed "BID SECURITY – RFP NO. IC/PC/2025/26-059" to the Club address on or before the bid submission deadline.

ITB 15. Deadline for Submission

15.1 Bids must be submitted through EPADS by **March 12, 2026 at 11:30 Hours**.

15.2 The original Bid Security must reach the Club by the same date and time.

ITB 16. Late Bids

16.1 EPADS does not accept bids after the closing date. Late submission of original Bid Security shall result in rejection.

E. BID OPENING AND EVALUATION

ITB 17. Bid Opening

17.1 Technical Bids will be opened on **March 12, 2026 at 12:00 Hours** at the Islamabad Club office, in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend.

17.2 Financial Bids will remain sealed and will be opened at a later date for technically qualified bidders only.

ITB 18. Confidentiality

18.1 Information relating to bid evaluation shall not be disclosed until the announcement of the evaluation report.

ITB 19. Clarification of Bids

19.1 The Employer may seek clarifications from bidders, but no change in the substance of the bid shall be permitted.

ITB 20. Examination of Bids

20.1 A substantially responsive bid is one that meets all eligibility criteria, is properly signed, is accompanied by required bid security, and conforms to all terms and conditions.

ITB 21. Evaluation and Comparison

21.1 **Stage 1 – Technical Evaluation:** Technical Bids will be evaluated on a pass/fail basis against the qualification criteria.

21.2 **Stage 2 – Financial Evaluation:** Financial Bids of technically qualified bidders will be opened and compared.

21.3 The contract shall be awarded to the bidder who qualifies the technical evaluation and offers the **lowest financial bid (price)**.

F. AWARD OF CONTRACT

ITB 22. Award Criteria

22.1 The Employer shall award the contract to the bidder whose bid is substantially responsive and offers the lowest evaluated price.

ITB 23. Employer's Rights

23.1 The Employer reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids without incurring any liability.

ITB 24. Notification of Award

24.1 The successful bidder shall be notified in writing (Letter of Acceptance).

ITB 25. Performance Security

25.1 The successful bidder shall furnish a Performance Security of **5% of the contract value** (annual) within seven (7) days of receiving the Letter of Acceptance.

ITB 26. Signing of Contract

26.1 The formal Contract Agreement shall be signed within ten (10) days of furnishing the Performance Security.

1. During the period when the ground is closed due to maintenance and no matches are held, the operator charges shall not apply, only maintenance charges apply.
2. All rates are inclusive of all applicable taxes.

SECTION 7: TERMS OF REFERENCE (SPECIFICATIONS)

7.1 Background

Islamabad Club possesses an electronic scoreboard at its Cricket Ground requiring professional operation and regular maintenance. The Club seeks to engage a specialized firm for comprehensive operation and maintenance services.

7.2 Scope of Work

A. Scoreboard Operation:

- Provide a dedicated, trained operator for all matches and events as scheduled by the Club.
- Operator shall report at least **02 hours prior** to the start of the match/event.
- Operator shall be responsible for accurate and timely display of scores, player statistics, and other information.
- Operator shall coordinate with match officials and Club representatives.

B. Software Maintenance:

- Regular maintenance and updates of the scoreboard software.
- Execution of minor error corrections, bug fixes, and adjustments/changes as and when required.
- Prior written notification to the Club before making any adjustments/changes.
- Resolution of software issues within **24 hours** of notification by the Club.

C. Hardware/Display Maintenance:

- Regular inspection and maintenance of the electronic display and associated hardware.
- During the cricket season: continuous monitoring and maintenance.
- During off-season (ground closed): **minimum 02 visits per month** for inspection.
- Prompt repair of any hardware malfunctions.

D. Reporting:

- Monthly maintenance reports to be submitted to the Club.
- Incident reports for any failures or major issues.

7.3 Service Levels and Penalties

- Operator reporting less than 02 hours prior to match: **25% deduction** of operating charges for that match.
- Software issue not resolved within 24 hours: Penalty as determined by the Club.
- Failure to provide operator for scheduled match: Deduction of full match charges + penalty.

7.4 Duration of Contract

The contract shall be valid for a period of **two (02) years** from the date of signing, subject to annual performance review and mutual agreement for renewal.

SECTION 8: GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (GCC)

8.1 Definitions

In the Contract, the following words and expressions shall have the meanings assigned to them:

- **"Contract"** means the Contract Agreement, the Letter of Acceptance, the Bid, these General Conditions, the Special Conditions, the Specifications, and all appendices.
- **"Contractor"** means the person(s) or firm named in the Letter of Acceptance whose bid has been accepted by the Employer.
- **"Employer"** means Islamabad Club.
- **"Engineer"** means the person appointed by the Employer to act as the Engineer for the purposes of the Contract (if applicable).
- **"Services"** means the work to be performed by the Contractor as described in the Specifications.
- **"Site"** means the Islamabad Club Cricket Ground and other locations where the Services are to be performed.
- **"Commencement Date"** means the date notified in the Letter of Acceptance or Contract Agreement.
- **"Time for Completion"** means the time for completing the Services as stated in the Special Conditions.
- **"Contract Price"** means the price defined in the Letter of Acceptance and the priced Bill of Quantities.
- **"Day"** means a calendar day.
- **"Month"** means a calendar month.
- **"Force Majeure"** means an exceptional event or circumstance beyond the control of the parties.

8.2 Interpretation

Words importing persons or parties shall include firms and organizations. Words importing singular shall include the plural where the context requires.

8.3 Law and Language

8.3.1 The Contract shall be governed by the laws of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

8.3.2 All communications shall be in the English language.

8.4 Priority of Contract Documents

In case of discrepancies, the priority of documents shall be:

1. Contract Agreement
2. Letter of Acceptance
3. Special Conditions of Contract (SCC)
4. General Conditions of Contract (GCC)
5. Specifications (Terms of Reference)
6. The priced Bill of Quantities
7. The Contractor's Technical Bid

8.5 Assignment

The Contractor shall not assign the Contract or any part thereof without the prior written consent of the Employer.

8.6 Subcontracting

The Contractor shall not subcontract the whole of the Services. Any subcontracting of parts of the Services requires the prior approval of the Employer. The Contractor shall remain fully liable for the acts and defaults of any subcontractor.

8.7 Contractor's General Obligations

The Contractor shall:

- Carry out the Services with due diligence, efficiency, and in accordance with the Contract.
- Provide all necessary supervision, labor, tools, equipment, and materials required for the Services.
- Comply with all security regulations of the Employer.
- Ensure that its personnel are suitably qualified and trained.
- Notify the Employer in writing prior to making any adjustments or changes to the software.

8.8 Contractor's Representative

The Contractor shall appoint a representative to supervise the execution of the Services and to receive instructions from the Employer. Such appointment shall be subject to the consent of the Employer.

8.9 Employer's Obligations

The Employer shall:

- Provide access to the Site and the scoreboard system.
- Provide match and event schedules in advance.
- Make timely payments as per the Contract.

8.10 Commencement and Time for Completion

8.10.1 The Contractor shall commence the Services on the Commencement Date and shall proceed with them without delay.

8.10.2 The Contractor shall complete the Services within the Time for Completion stated in the Special Conditions.

8.11 Programme

The Contractor shall submit a detailed programme of service delivery to the Employer for approval within 7 days of the Commencement Date.

8.12 Extension of Time

The Contractor shall be entitled to an extension of the Time for Completion if the completion of Services is delayed by any event caused by the Employer or by Force Majeure. The Contractor shall notify the Employer within 7 days of the occurrence of such event.

8.13 Penalties and Liquidated Damages

8.13.1 If the Contractor fails to comply with the service levels specified in the Terms of Reference, penalties as specified in the Special Conditions shall apply.

8.13.2 If the Contractor fails to complete the Services within the Time for Completion, the Contractor shall pay liquidated damages to the Employer at the rate specified in the Special Conditions.

8.14 Taking Over

Upon completion of the Services, the Contractor shall notify the Employer. The Employer shall inspect the Services and issue a Taking-Over Certificate within 7 days of satisfactory completion.

8.15 Defect Liability

The Contractor shall remedy any defects in the Services arising during the Defect Liability Period stated in the Special Conditions at no cost to the Employer.

8.16 Contract Price and Payment

8.16.1 The Contract Price shall be as stated in the Letter of Acceptance.

8.16.2 Payment shall be made monthly in arrears within 30 days of receipt of a correct invoice.

8.16.3 All taxes and duties shall be included in the Contract Price.

8.17 Variation

The Employer may order variations to the Services. The Contractor shall not make any variation without an instruction from the Employer. Variations shall be valued on the basis of the rates in the Bill of Quantities or, if not applicable, at reasonable rates agreed between the parties.

8.18 Default of Contractor

If the Contractor abandons the Services, fails to proceed with due diligence, or refuses to comply with a valid instruction, the Employer may give a default notice. If the Contractor fails to remedy the default within 14 days, the Employer may terminate the Contract.

8.19 Default of Employer

If the Employer fails to make payment in accordance with the Contract, the Contractor may give a default notice. If payment is not made within 14 days, the Contractor may suspend the Services.

8.20 Force Majeure

If Force Majeure occurs, the Contractor shall notify the Employer immediately. If the event continues for 84 days, either party may terminate the Contract.

8.21 Insurance

The Contractor shall maintain, at its own cost:

- Public liability insurance of at least PKR 1 million.
- Workers' compensation insurance for its personnel.
- Insurance for any equipment brought onto the Site.

8.22 Confidentiality

The Contractor shall treat all information obtained from the Employer as confidential and shall not disclose it to any third party without the Employer's consent.

8.23 Intellectual Property

8.23.1 All software, designs, and documents provided by the Employer shall remain the property of the Employer.

8.23.2 Any software modifications or enhancements developed specifically for the Employer under this Contract shall be the property of the Employer.

8.23.3 The Contractor warrants that the Services shall not infringe any patent, copyright, or other intellectual property right.

8.24 Performance Security

8.24.1 The Contractor shall provide a Performance Security of 5% of the Contract Price within 7 days of the Letter of Acceptance.

8.24.2 The Performance Security shall be valid until 30 days after the expiry of the Defect Liability Period.

8.24.3 The Performance Security may be forfeited if the Contractor fails to perform its obligations under the Contract.

8.25 Settlement of Disputes

8.25.1 Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Contract shall be settled amicably. If amicable settlement is not reached, the dispute shall be settled in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration Act, 1940 (X of 1940).
